How does the market pay for things – pay for things and be reimbursed (Nancy)

8X reflective vests – vests should be laundered after each market and redistributed

Nancy -- # of volunteers ?

Each vendor supplies 1 volunteer each at their tents

Farmers Market Coalition – possible sharing of volunteers

Carolyn – possible shifts – Henry 6:30-9:30 and 9:30-12noon

No need for Senior Hour

Albert – Berlin Market – people loose just walking down the streets (blocked of two streets)

'Tent' in middle for volunteer break and Market Master with distance between

Vendors allowed 2 vehicles behind their tent – additional vendor and volunteer parking may be assigned at sole discretion of BBFM BoD elsewhere

Jerry – downtown parking?? Garfield Pkwy – 20 minute parking?? Other is resident parking with tag??

FUNDS - Nancy – one of volunteers offered donation – should this be put on website/FB?

Carolyn + Nancy write a blurb about donations

DISCUSSION

Vendors will be asked for reason for their opt-out

Those vendors who opt out will be out for the season

Individual situations will be discussed, and if approved their fee will be refunded
