Move forward and send a plan to town and dept of ag and to say that the town has approved Is the town ok with both lots – not aware if Jerry has asked for this

Submit the BBFM Plan to the Town and request the 2 lots – PNC and Gravel lot

Review the plan and send to Town Mon. or Tues. - BoD edits were made by Henry

Not sure if each market sends a plan to Dept of Ag and Dept of Public Health and Governor after approval from Town Watch the stream at 2:30 – see what may affect our procedure

Farmers market coalition updated the 'Rules' - need input on that doc sent to BoD

How many shoppers do we limit to at one time – one person per 150square feet – 24??

If Market master and volunteers and one volunteer per vendor move people along – if all people stop at one tent – too many – up to the volunteers to keep the pace

Depends on the 2:30 presentation today --- we can gear path forward around it – do we put our funds into maybe a paid position for monitoring???
