JC – will bring ‘personal amplifier’**

**PARKING**

12 Parking passes – they are generally dated Summer Sundays throughout the season until Sept. within the market hours – 6:30 – 12:30 – good at any parking space - Doug numbered them in order to keep track of who has which numbered tag

**Volunteers (Carolyn)**

Sent a copy of the chart to all of us – good through June – 11 shifts to fill
